**Subject: Regarding Online registration of patients in Central Registry System.**

In continuation to the letter no: 3/26/18-3H6/ 1285582/1-2 dated 31/7/18 regarding Standard Operating Procedure for Private de-addiction centers who are providing de-addiction treatment services to persons with substance abuse, it has been mentioned that every private de-addiction center licensed by State Government will be linked with the computerized patient registry system of the Department of Health and family welfare, Govt of Punjab, in order to ensure that a patient does not get same medication from multiple sources.

A Training regarding central Registry system has been scheduled for the private deaddictioncenters which are licensed by the department as per the following schedule:

I	Bathinda, Barnala, Sangrur, Muktsar, Fazilka, Faridkot, Ferozepur	Video Conference room, Civil Hospital Bathinda. On 7/9/18.
II	Hoshiarpur, Jalandhar, Ludhiana, Moga, Nawanshahr,	Seminar hall, civil hospital Ludhiana on 7/9/18
III	Amritsar, Tarntaran, Gurdaspur, Kapurthala, Pathankot,	Conference hall, Civil Hospital, Amritsaron 7/9/18

User ID and password for the concerned de-addiction center will be provided through the office of Deputy Medical Commissioner of the concerned district.

Therefore, it is directed that this online registry system must be implemented by all the private de-addiction centers by 15/09/18. In case of non-compliance, action will be initiated to cut off the supply of medicines.
